

# Save 151 Days in IRB Review with a Seamless, Coordinated Submission Process

In the example below, we examine a study that did not leverage that centralized network, and show the comparative benefits if the study had leveraged WCG IRB for streamlined review and centralized process.

### EXAMPLE: PHASE II STUDY

This study was conducted without using the WCG IRB central submission process, adding significantly to their IRB review turnaround time (TAT):



**67 central sites (1 day TAT each)**

28 sites each submitting protocol and site application individually to WCG IRB (15 day TAT each - submitted over XX weeks)

**TOTAL TAT - 487 DAYS**

If the study had been submitted centrally through WCG IRB:



**67 central sites (1 day TAT each)**

28 sites submit directly to WCG IRB (3 day TAT each - concurrent review)

**TOTAL TAT - 336 DAYS**
